Yarn

Scraps amounts of 8ply in various colours

Needles

4.00mm (I used shortest possible, 2 x dpns)

Notions

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Embellish-Knit (optional)

Clover medium Pom Pom Maker (optional)

Abbreviations

Garter = Knit every row

K = Knit

K2tog = knit 2 together

CDD = Centre double decrease, slip 2 as if to knit together knit 1, pass the 2 slipped stitches back over the top of the knit stitch

Cord

Make your strand in the length you want, and using the method you prefer, I recommend at least 1.5m

Present!

Instructions

Using 4mm needles cast on 10 stitches

Knit in garter for approx. 10 rows (if you want a square pressie) or 12 if you want a rectangle.

Cast off leaving a 10 cm tail for sewing to your Cord.



Tree!

Instructions

Using 4mm needles cast on 14 stitches

Row 1 k1, k2tog, k to last 3 stitches, k2tog, k1

Row 2 Knit across all stitches

Repeat Rows 1 & 2 until 4 stitches remaining

K1 k2tog k1

Knit 3 stitches

CDD

Cast off leaving 10 cm tail for sewing to your cord.



Lolly!

Instructions

Using 4mm needles cast on 7 stitches

Knit in garter for approx. 10 rows

Cast off leaving a 10 cm tail for sewing to your Cord.

Cut 2 ties approximately 10cm each and tie one strand around. the 3rd row and make a small tight bow. Repeat for the 3rd last row,



Assembly

Using a weaving in needle, stitch each of your cuties onto the i-cord at regular intervals. If you want to use this for cards make sure the spaces are at least 15cm for standard cards.
